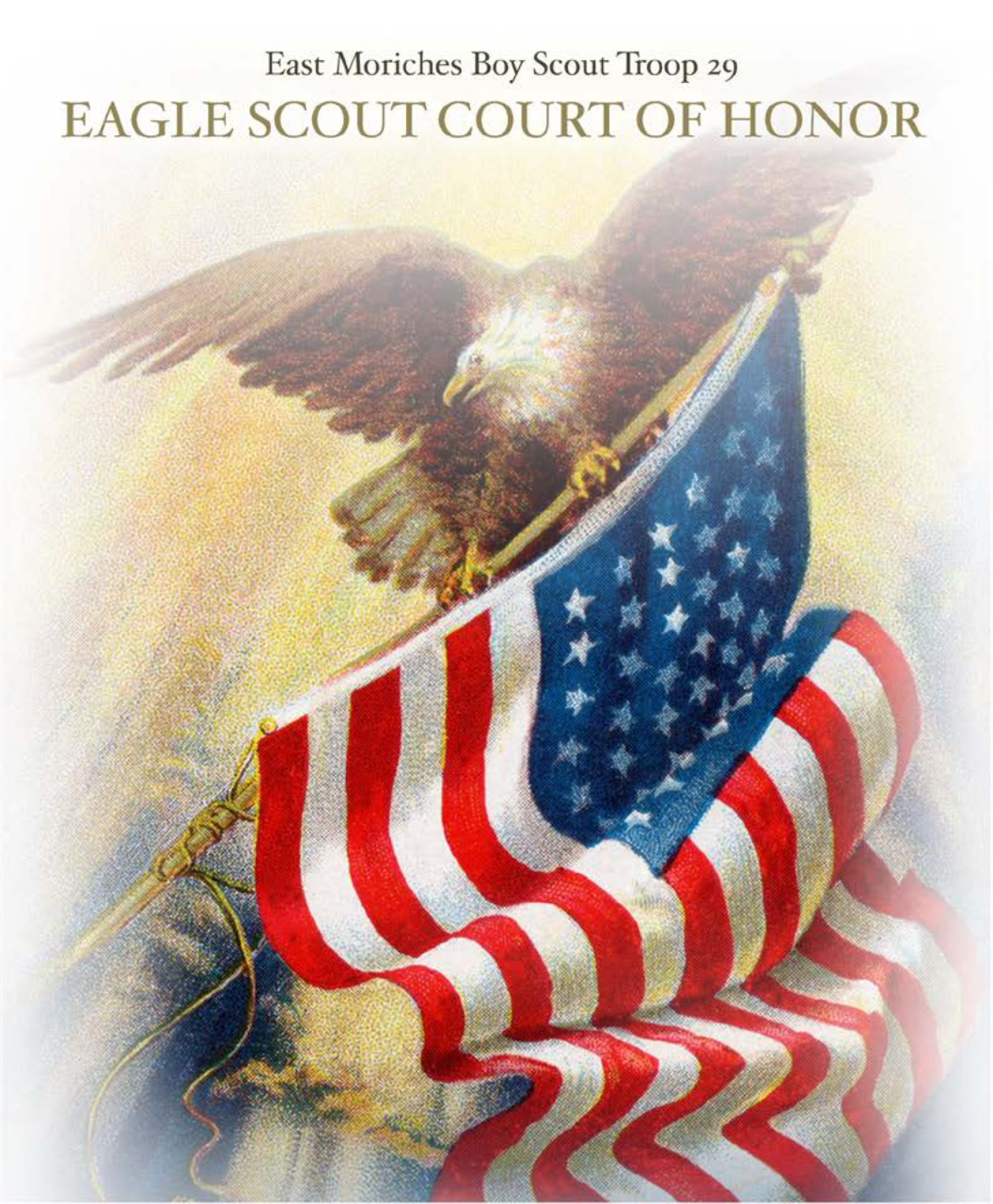

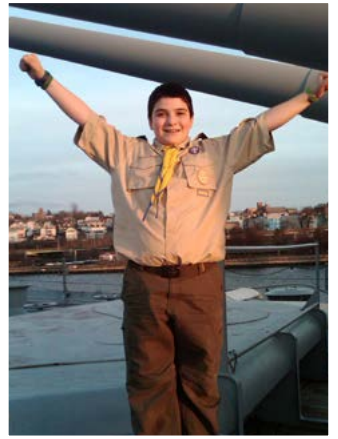
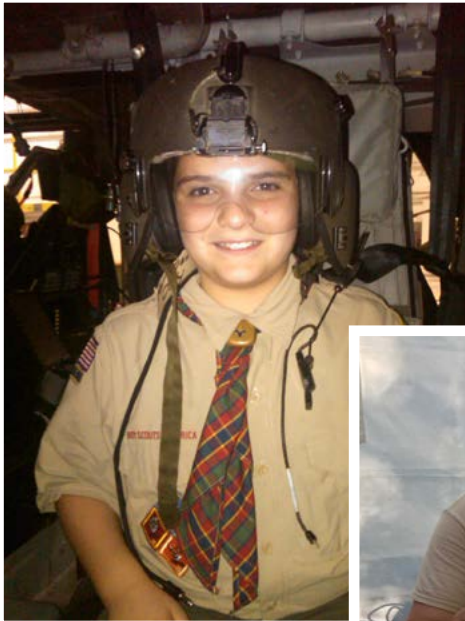

## EAGLE SCOUT PROJECT

**Project Description:** The purchase, assembly, and installation of a wood and vinyl swing set/climbing structure to be utilized and enjoyed by the members and the family and friends of members of VFW Post 5350, Westhampton Beach, NY.

### Swing Set/Playset/Climbing Structure:

- Model: Swing Kingdom KC-5 Deluxe Swing Set/Climbing Structure
- Purchased from: Wood Kingdom, 111 Milbar Blvd, Farmingville, NY 11735
- Overall Dimensions: 19'w x 16'd x 11'h
- Weight: 1,098 lbs. • Color: Almond PVC, Green accents
- Tower: 5' x 5' Deck • Roof: 5' x 5' Pyramid • Deck Height: 5'
- Slide: 10' Avalanche Slide • Swing Beam: 4 position climber
- Swings: 2 x Belt Swings, 1 x Infant Swing, 1 x Plastic Glider

### Play Area Ground Preparation:

- Dimensions: 24' x 25' x 12"
- Two rows of 6x6 #2 railroad ties installed as a border
- Area was excavated. Some dirt from the excavation was spread around the rest of the property. Excess dirt then removed from the property with the help of adult volunteers.
- Area then back filled with certified engineered wood mulch (12" deep)

### Fundraising:

Funds to cover the cost of materials was raised via monetary donations, material donations, as well as a Pancake Breakfast held at the VFW Post 5350 on Sunday, June 4th, 2017.
